2016 RIDGE TRAIL HIGHLIGHTS



Added 2.5 miles of new Ridge Trail on Milagra Ridge, and Pacifica and Daly City streets. This creates an 80-mile continuous stretch from Novato to south of Highway 92 in San Mateo. Trek away!



New logo released: With funding and pro-bono marketing from REI Co-op, the Ridge Trail released a new logo that features its name more prominently and will stand out more on the trail.



Silicon Valley Trail Loop Study released in conjunction with the Bay Trail and the City of San Jose. The study includes a web tool that lets you plan trips on trails and transit and calculates carbon emissions savings.



2 miles of new Ridge Trail open in **Vargas Plateau Regional Park.** Due to litigation concerning the road, the park closed shortly after opening. We are hopeful that it will open again this year. Stay tuned!




