



Distance: 7.75 miles

1.47 miles: Fernandez Ranch Trailhead at Christie Rd to EBMUD Pinole Watershed

4.35 miles: EBMUD Pinole Watershed Entrance to Sobrante Ridge Trail in Sobrante Ridge Regional Park (EBRPD)

1.93 miles: Sobrante Ridge Trail to Conestoga Way

From: Fernandez Ranch Trailhead at Christie Rd

To: EBMUD Pinole Watershed

Access to 3 miles of multi-use trail, including 1 mile accessible to wheelchairs. Picnic sites are available at trailhead and along Black Phoebe Trail.

East Bay Municipal Utility District's Pinole Watershed Ridge Trail connects its west end to Pinole Valley Park and Sobrante Ridge Regional park. The trail is mostly on historic ranch roads, some very steep, climbing over 400 feet through rangeland and oak woodlands and providing sweeping views from Mt Diablo to the distant Solano hills across the Carquinez Strait.

To: Conestoga Way

On the wide, partially shaded, ridgetop trail you'll take in remarkable views of the mountains that ring the bay; the narrow southern leg (closed to bicycles) descends 320 feet in less than a mile.
