

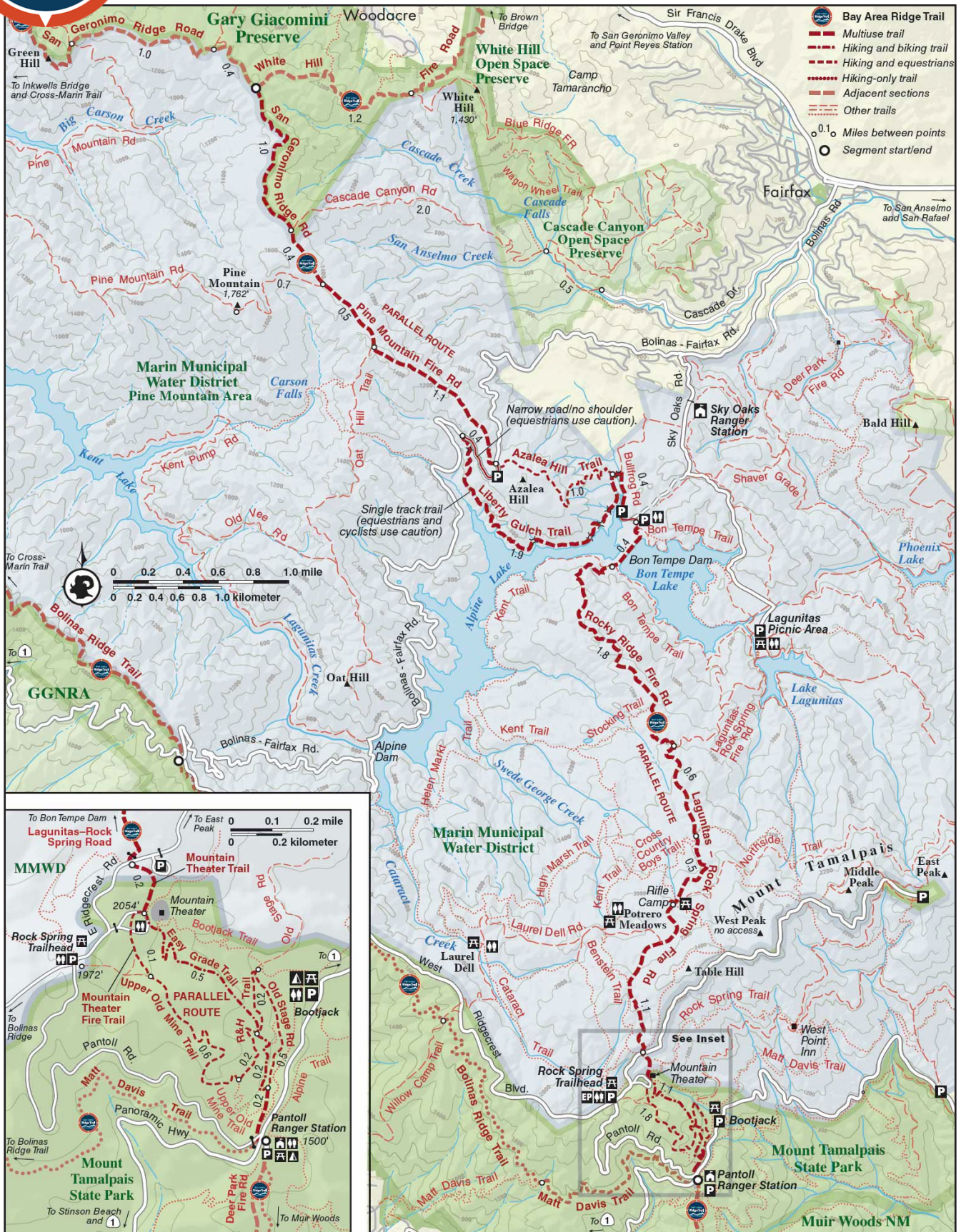


Mount Tamalpais Watershed Bike and Equestrian Parallel

Marin County

From: East Ridgecrest Blvd

To: West End of White Hill Fire Rd



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Length: 9.8 miles one-way

Elevation Gain: 1,292 feet

Accessibility: Hikers, bicyclists, and equestrians

This Parallel Ridge Trail segment travels through the Mount Tamalpais Watershed and offers stunning views of the San Francisco Bay and Pacific Ocean. This Parallel Trail serves as an off-street option for Bikers and Equestrians to accommodate the Use-Gap between PanToll Campground and the Bolinas Ridge Trailhead. *Equestrians should use the Azalea Hill Trail between Bullfrog Fire Road and Pine Mountain Trailhead.*
